Will new energy storage be more expensive in 2025?

The NDRC said new energy storage that uses electrochemical means is expected to see further technological advances, with its system cost to be further lowered by more than 30 percent in 2025 compared to the level at the end of 2020.

How much energy storage will China have by 2025?

China aims to have 20% of its total electricity generation capacity by 2025. In light of development objectives and approaches for energy storage set out in China's 14th five-year plan, China's National Energy Administration, the country's major energy policymaking authority, has launched a series of supporting policies regarding storage investment, pricing, etc.

The backlog of new power generation and energy storage seeking transmission connections across the U.S. grew again in 2023, with nearly 2,600 gigawatts (GW) of generation and storage capacity now actively seeking grid interconnection, according to new research from Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory (Berkeley Lab).

We estimate that by 2040, LDES deployment could result in the avoidance of 1.5 to 2.3 gigatons of CO₂ equivalent per year, or around 10 to 15 percent of today's power sector emissions. In the United States alone, LDES could reduce the overall cost of achieving a fully decarbonized power system by around \$35 billion annually by 2040.
