What do monocytes look like?

The monocyte's nucleus appears dark purple in the center of the cell and can take the shape of: A lumpy kidney bean. A horseshoe. A lopsided circle. A circle with an indentation. Where are monocytes located? Monocytes form in the soft tissue of your bones (bone marrow).

What is the incubation period of Mono?

The period of time between exposure and the start of symptoms is called the incubation period. Though you may feel OK during this time, it's still possible for you to pass the virus on to others. The first stage of mono is called the prodrome stage. It usually lasts three to five days. Mono symptoms start to appear during this phase.

Is mono a contagious disease?

Mono is a contagious illness that is usually caused by the Epstein-Barr virus. Mono has three stages: prodrome (when symptoms start), acute stage (when symptoms worsen), and convalescent (recovery). Mono has a long incubation period, so it can be difficult to pinpoint when the illness actually started.

Can mono be cured?

There's no cure or specific treatment for mono. It can take a long time to get over the infection, and there's not much you can do to make the process go faster. Supporting your body as it heals and fights off the virus is the best approach. You can do this by:

How long does it take to recover from Mono?

On average, the prodrome phase lasts three to five days, the acute phase typically lasts between 4 and 6 weeks, and the final recovery stage can go on for up to six months. Is Mono an STD?
