What is a compressed air energy storage project?

A compressed air energy storage (CAES) project in Hubei, China, has come online, with 300MW/1,500MWh of capacity. The 5-hour duration project, called Hubei Yingchang, was built in two years with a total investment of CNY1.95 billion (US\$270 million) and uses abandoned salt mines in the Yingcheng area of Hubei, China's sixth-most populous province.

Will China accelerate the development of compressed air energy storage projects?

Now, China is expected to accelerate the development of its far less prevalent compressed air energy storage (CAES) projects to optimize its power grid performance and move in a greener direction.

Where is a 100 mw compressed air energy storage system located?

A 100 MW compressed air energy storage system in Zhangjiakou, China. The Institute of Engineering Thermophysics of the Chinese Academy of Sciences has switched on a 100 MW compressed air energy storage (CAES) plant in Zhangjiakou, in China's Hebei province.

How efficient is China's new compressed air plant?

According to China Energy Storage Alliance, the new plant can store and release up to 400 MWh, at a system design efficiency of 70.4%. That's huge; current compressed air systems are only around 40-52% efficient, and even the two larger Hydrostor CAES plants scheduled to open in California in 2026 are only reported to be around 60% efficient.

How efficient is compressed air energy storage?

The round-trip efficiency of compressed air energy storage ranges from about 40% (commercially realized) to about 70%(still at the theoretical stage, although a recent 10 MW scale system designed and built by Institute of Engineering Thermophysics of Chinese Academy of Sciences and partners, have indicated a round trip efficiency of ~60%).

The project adopts a combined compressed air and lithium-ion battery energy storage system, with a total installed capacity of 50 MW/200 MWh and a discharge duration of 4 hours.
