

Does Italy need 9gw/71gwh of energy storage?

Italy's TSO Terna says it needs 9GW/71GWh of energy storage by integrate its renewables pipeline. Image: Terna. The European Union (EU) Commission has approved a state aid scheme aiming to fund the rollout of over 9GW/71GWh of energy storage in Italy.

How much energy does Italy need?

The 187MW project in Piemonte will be submitted for approval later this year. Terna (the Italian TSO) estimates in the last Adequacy Report for the Italian Electricity System that Italy will need around 27GW of energy storage capacity by 2033 to add a planned 120 GW+ of renewable generation to the Italian grid.

How much power will Italy have next year?

From ESS News Italy's latest capacity market auction for power to be delivered next year assigned 42.2 GW of capacity, data published by transmission system operator Terna showed. These include nearly 37.6 GW of existing capacity, around 233 MW of new capacity, as well as 4.36 GW of capacity from abroad.

Which projects have been submitted to the Italian Ministry of energy?

The 111MW project in Lombardia and the 97MW project in Puglia have been submitted to the Italian Ministry of Energy for approval. The 187MW project in Piemonte will be submitted for approval later this year.

Which projects have a battery energy storage system been implemented?

Internationally, we have already implemented major projects such as the Tynemouth stand-alone storage system in the UK and the La Caba; a photovoltaic plant in Chile, which is equipped with a Battery Energy Storage System that ensures its efficiency and stability.

Utility and power generation company Enel Group and Brenmiller Energy have inaugurated a thermal energy storage system in Italy using the latter's proprietary bGen technology. Israel-based Brenmiller's energy storage unit has been deployed at a power plant in Santa Barbara, Tuscany, and will help the plant to use renewable energy, by ...
