Originally issued in the mid-70s, the SBG line became celebrated for its cool looks, ridiculous sustain and awesome versatility. With its intricate aesthetic detail and individually handcrafted workmanship, it's no wonder guitarists as wide ranging as Bob Marley and Al Di Meola took to the SBG series.

When did SGB 2016 Series II mature?

The SGB 2016 Series II matured on 28 March 2024(since 29 March 2024 is a holiday) after its completion of the 8-year period. The SGB 2016 Series II was issued on 29 March 2016, and the final redemption amount is Rs. 6,601 for each SGB unit.

Who played a sbg3000 electric guitar?

Al McKay of Earth Wind & Fire played one. Bill Nelson of Bebop Deluxe played one. Carlos Santana made them famous. Yamaha Guitars commemorates its 40th year selling guitars in the United States by reissuing the SBG3000 solidbody electric guitar.

How much does SGB 2016 Series I cost?

The issue price of SGB 2016 Series I was Rs. 2,600 per gram, and the final redemption amount is Rs. 6,271 for each SGB unit. The SGB 2016 Series II matured on 28 March 2024 (since 29 March 2024 is a holiday) after its completion of the 8-year period.

When will SGBS be redeemed prematurely?

On 15 July 2024 and 19 July 2024, the RBI announced the premature redemption price of three SGBs issued in 2019-20 (Series II), 2018-19 (Series V) and 2017-18 (Series II). The premature redemption price of Series II of SGB 2019-20 is Rs. 7,272 per unit of SGBs, which can be redeemed prematurely on 16 July 2024.

What is the final redemption price for SGB 2016 series I?

Thus, the final redemption price for the SGB 2016 Series I redemption due on 8 February 2024 is Rs. 6,271 per unit of SGB based on the simple average of closing price of gold for the week of 29 January - 02 February 2024.
